THE KRAKEN

GENERAL INFORMATION: THE KRAKEN is a blend of an advanced polymer and solvent chemistry. This chemistry is designed to support a uniform wetting and rewetting characteristic while providing a consistent penetration. THE KRAKEN's formulation delivers fast hydration, and reduces excessive moisture. It is use of two advanced surfactants that provide the ultimate playing surface. Recommended where tournament/game day conditions are demanded, golf courses, athletic fields, tennis, lawn bowling and other grass sporting fields.

THE KRAKEN, with its aggressive formula, improves moisture distribution in a variety of sand and non-sand based soil types relieving the effects severe stress conditions. When applied in a program prior to the onset of hydrophobic conditions, it will prevent their effects. **THE KRAKEN** will enhance rooting and overall turf vigor when used in monthly programs.

THE KRAKEN provides an efficient mechanism that improves irrigation use and water savings.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Standard Program: Apply 6 fl oz. of THE KRAKEN per 1000 sq. ft. in 2 gallons of water (185 mL/100 m2 in 8 L of water). Apply monthly, beginning at least one month prior to the onset of stress conditions. Irrigation should be applied before next mowing to enhance product movement into the soil.

Biweekly Program: Initial application, apply 6 fl oz. of THE KRAKEN per 1000 sq. ft. in 2 gallons of water (185 mL/100 m2 in 8 L of water). After initial applications, apply biweekly at 3 fl oz. per 1000 sq ft. Initial 6 fl oz. applications are critical to maintaining a biweekly program.

Tank Mixing: THE KRAKEN may be tank mixed with other commonly used turf chemicals and fertilizers at rates not to exceed 6 oz per 1000 sq. ft. If applicator is unfamiliar with the performance of this product in tank mixes under user's growing conditions, THE KRAKEN should be tested prior to large-scale application. The applicator should always exercise judgment and caution when using this and all other turf products. Tank mixing THE KRAKEN other products is intended as a matter of convenience; this product is not intended to enhance the performance of other tank mixed components.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Store in original container only. Do not add anything to the container. Keep container tightly sealed when not in use. Do not store near fire, flame or other potential sources of ignition.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Triple rinse (or equivalent) during mixing and loading. Recycling decontaminated containers is the best method of disposing containers if allowed by law.
